



Liphook to Waggoners Wells and return 8.35 kilometres [5.2 miles]

A walk through heathland and forest with some short steep hills

Start at the layby opposite Radford Park next to the commemorative plaque to Canadian Soldiers in WW 1 and WW2. Cross the road and head up the hill towards the A3 trunk Road and take the first turning on the right Hewshott Lane at waypoint 3.

Turn left at waypoint 6 and following the public footpath sign along a private drive until a pedestrian gate is reached at waypoint 7.

From here walk along a path adjacent to a field with open views across to a mobile phone mast. At the end of the path at waypoint 8 walk up the drive adjacent to a house turning left at a barn waypoint 9

Then follow the lane down the hill until a gate is reached at waypoint 10. Go through the gateway and walk up the short steep hill to waypoint 10.

At the top go straight on ignoring the paths to the left and right and walk over the heathland to waypoint 11. Turn left and follow the path to the Canadian army memorial at waypoint 12 before going under the A3 via the underpass at waypoint 13.

After the walking through the underpass climb the hill and go straight on up to the tarmac track at waypoint 14. Turn right and go along to the end of the tarmac at waypoint 15 when you turn left.

Go along this track continuing up a steep slope at waypoint 16, go straight on and then along to waypoint 17; then to waypoint 18 which is near the lake at Waggoners Wells.

From Waypoint 18 walk along the path by the lake to the second dam on the right. Cross the bridge and turn left. Pass the National Trust's wishing well at waypoint 22.

From the wishing well cross the bridge at waypoint 23 and follow the path up the hill to waypoint 24, then down into the valley to waypoint 25 and then up the hill to the car park at waypoint 26.

From the car park go down Rectory Lane turning right at the end to go past the Bramshott signs. Carry on down the lane the lane approximately 900 metres , passing the Grade 2 Listed 'Downlands' mansion on your right, into

the centre of the village, turn left at waypoint 27. Enter the church yard through the lych gate at waypoint 28. Pass through the Churchyard passing the Grade 2 Listed Canadian memorial and war graves. Carry on through the entrance gateway designed by Inigo Triggs and follow the path under the A3 bridge to the start point of this walk.
